Three-month outlook

Moderately constructive base case if Muse engagement holds and advertising growth remains healthy in the low-to-mid-20% range, which could allow the shares to work toward recently raised bullish targets in the roughly \$800-920 area. Core ads were strong in Q2, and the distribution advantage is real. Material uncertainties include the pace of Muse monetization (subscriptions, commerce, incremental ads) relative to \$130-145B 2026 capex and weak free cash flow, risk of further spending increases, legal and regulatory overhangs (including youth-safety and privacy issues), and the fact that a large part of the narrative may already be reflected after an approximately 35% one-month rally at a TTM P/E near 28-29. A Q3 disappointment (results expected late October) or fading Muse metrics could drive a retracement toward the \$650-700 area. Market sentiment

Recent X discussion among traders and investors is net constructive but not unanimous. Bullish posts focus on Muse as a potential monetization layer on a very large daily-user base, ongoing AI-driven advertising strength, and higher analyst targets, with some near-term trading levels cited in the high \$770s to around \$790 and support watched near \$725-730. Skeptical posts question broad adoption of always-on hardware (glasses and pendant) and whether Muse utility is being overstated in the short run even if the longer-term agent thesis is plausible. Social sentiment is a noisy, non-representative sample and can shift quickly with price action.

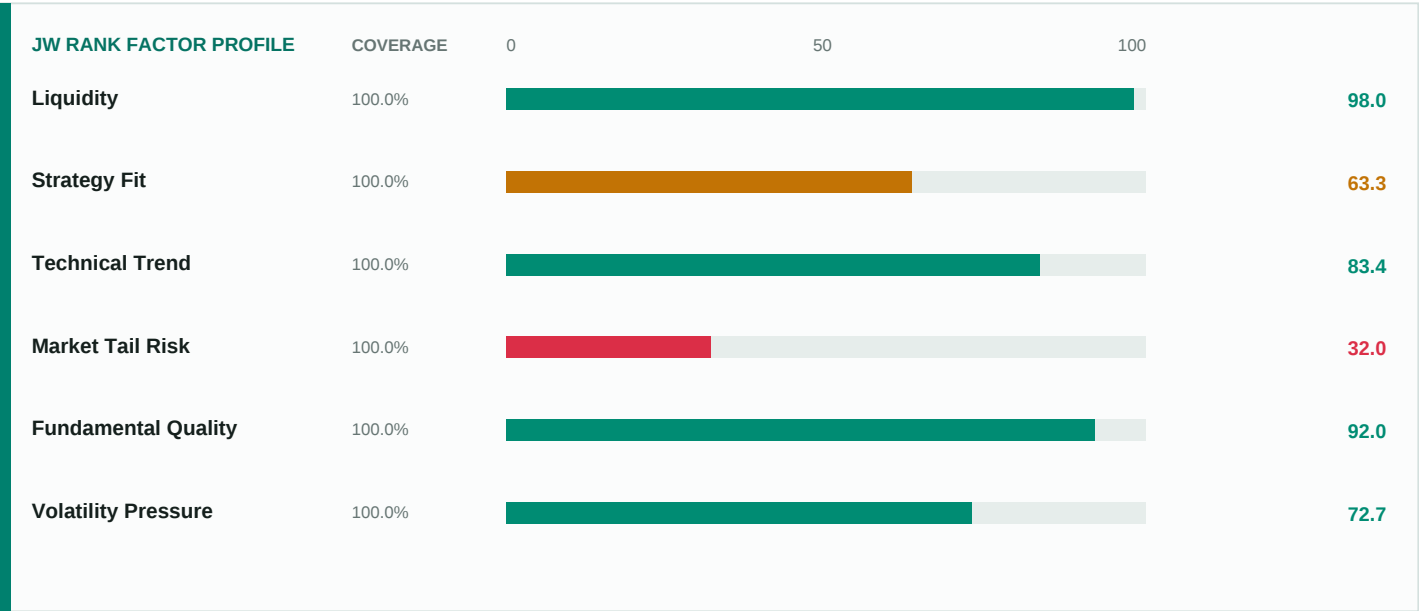

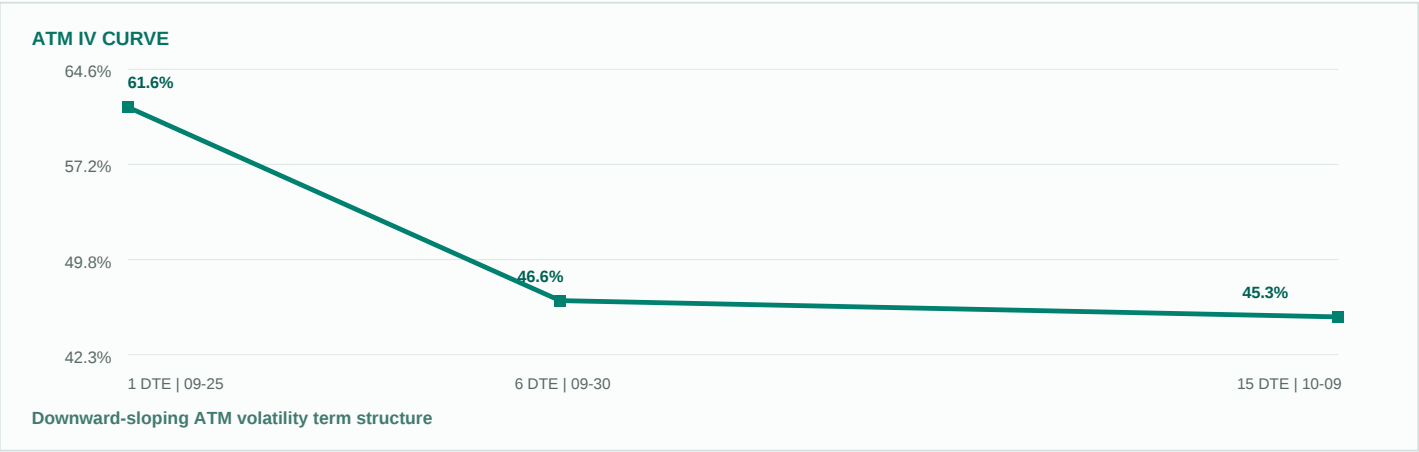
